## **Law school chooses location**

Charlotte School of Law has chosen 1211 E. Morehead St. as the site where it will begin classes in August.

The address is a three-story, Georgian-style brick building with a 16,000-square-foot skylit atrium that will house offices, seminar rooms, student areas, teaching space and a library.

The law school will be at this location for two years while preparations are made for the design and construction of a permanent facility.

Infilaw, the school's Florida-based parent, is owned by Sterling Capital Partners, a private equity fund. Infilaw operates two other schools: Florida Coastal School of Law, which opened in 1996, and Phoenix International School of Law, which opened in 2005.
