

## Charlotte's First Law School to Anchor Development of Bryant Park

The **Charlotte School of Law** (CharlotteLaw), part of the InfiLaw Consortium of Independent Law Schools, has chosen its permanent location for the school next to historic Bryant Park at the Western Gateway to Charlotte's Center City District.

CharlotteLaw has signed an agreement for a long-term lease on the property, located at the intersection of Suttle

Avenue and Wilkinson Boulevard. The development, named Bryant Park after the adjacent city park on West Morehead, is currently the site of the Radiator Specialty Company. Plans call for the construction of a four-story, 102,000-square-foot building to house classrooms, law library, offices, clinics, moot court, meeting space and student organization areas.

"The Bryant Park development will provide a state-of-the-art facility with the convenience of free parking. The central location, its close proximity to Uptown Charlotte and easy access to the area's interstate system puts all of Charlotte's amenities in easy reach of our students as well as the community that utilizes our law library."
